Participant shall ensure that the event and all activities related in any way are conducted in a safe manner.

Participant shall indemnify and hold harmless Gerald R. Ford International Airport Authority, its Board, employees and agents from and against any and all claims or demands and all expenses incidental thereto, based upon or arising out of damages to persons or property related in any way to Participant's activities at the Airport.

Participant agrees to clean, restore, repair and pay for any damage to Airport property, facilities or equipment as a result of the event.

Participant's activity will not involve public access to the airport terminal building and therefore will not need to have general liability insurance.

Date(s) of Participant's Activities: February 5, 2017 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm

Description of Participant's Activities: A protest will occur on the NE corner of Patterson and 44<sup>th</sup> Street. Parking will take place in the economy lot. A march will proceed from the start of the parking lot and move the full length of the economy lot and turn around. At all times protesters will follow the direction of airport and law enforcement officials. This is for the safety of everyone involved.

Protesters will not block roadways that are not controlled by police.

Protesters will not block crosswalks in front of the terminal.

Protesters will not impede the traveling public.

Protesters will not enter the terminal building.

Any deviation of these rules may result in appropriate civil and criminal actions.
