

Investigating the Non-Profit Industrial Complex in West Michigan

In this 8 – week class we will investigate what some social theorists have identified as the non-profit industrial complex.

The non-profit industrial complex consists of the non-profit organizations and their relationship to foundations, other funders and the state. The class will investigate these dynamics in a broad sense using the book, *The Revolution Will Not Be Funded: Beyond the Non-Profit Industrial Complex*.

In addition to exploring this issue in a theoretical way, the class will also look at how the non-profit industrial complex functions in West Michigan, which will involve an investigation into non-profits, foundations and how that impacts social movements and social justice.

Classes will meet on Wednesdays from 6 – 8pm starting January 23rd 2013. Location is to be determined. Cost of the class is \$20.
